

What is NorTrials?

- Launched as part of the ambitious strategic plan promoted by the Norwegian Ministry of Health and Care Services to strengthen Norway as a country of excellence for performing clinical trials
- Represents a public-private partnership between the Norwegian healthcare system and the healthcare industry
- **NorTrials Coordinating Unit** is the operational structure for the follow-up of the six NorTrials centres and national support for industry initiated clinical trials
- NorTrials will benefit from the Norwegian healthcare system and infrastructure

Why NorTrials?

- Give patients increased access to investigational treatment throughout the country
- A national entry point for healthcare industry who wants to conduct clinical trials in Norway
- **Dedicated NorTrials contact persons** throughout the Norwegian healthcare system, prepared for dialogue with the health industry upon request
- Facilitation of **collaboration between study sites** for all therapeutic areas and clinical trial phases

- Promote Norway as a preferred country for performing clinical trials for the health industry




